## How to separate and put out garbage

## • For details on sorting, please see the garbage sorting manual.

• Items that cannot be put into designated garbage bags and have the tops of the bags tied up will be considered bulky garbage. (fees apply)

#### Recycleable

### Tie them crosswise ith string according to type.

Even if you only put out one, please tie it with string.

#### Newspapers(including inserts)



OThin booklets should be classified as "Mag azines and other paper.'

#### Cardboard

Only those with corrugafed edges are accepted.

ORemove as much adhesive

tape, fasteners, etc. as possible.



### Paper pack

Only items with a white interior(Not aluminum coated) are eligible. Anything else should be disposed of as "burnable garbage". ORinse, cut open and dry.

#### Magazines and other papers

OPaper boxes such as tissue boxes should be crushed before disposal.

Remove everything except the paper.

OPlace small papers(postcards, envelopes, etc.) in a paper bag and

tie it with string to prevent them from scattering.

## Can(Limited to beverages/

and food)

O Caps and lids are [Non-burnable garbage] .

O Do not crush them so they can be recycled.





### Bottles(For beverages and food only)

- O Crowns, caps, and broken items are non-burnable waste.
- O If possible, have retailers take back 1.8L bottles and beer bottles.

#### Plastic bottle



Only items with a recycling mark are accepted.

OLabels and caps go under

"Plastic containers and packaging".

Oil bottles go on in the burnable waste category. OWater server bottles should be disposed of as burnable waste.

O Do not crush so that can be recycled.

#### White tray

O A white polystyrene foam plate for food. (Fresh fish, meat, prepared foods, vegetables)

O Food trays other than white should be classified as "Plastic containers and packaging".

### Burnable garbage Food waste, clothing,

Shimomachi(Only Oakitsu · Makibuchi)

O Drain food waste thoroughly before disposing of it.

O Remove metal fittings from clothing,

hoes, bags, etc. before putting them out. O Skewers and other sharp objects can cause injury,

o they should be broken or wrapped before disposed o



Only disposable diapers may be disposed of in transparent bags.

## Plastic containers and packaging(waste plastic)

O The items to be collected are marked with the plastic symbol. Outer

bentoboxes and side dishes, caps and labels for plastic bottles, tofu and egg cartons, colored food trays, etc.

If there is any dirt or residue, wash it off with water before lisposal. If the dirt cannot be removed, dispose of it as burnable garbage."

O Do not chop it up into small pieces.

Since plastic products cannot be collected as plastic ontainers and packaging, they should be disposed of as





- OEquipment that uses fluorocarbons. (dehumidifiers, etc.)→Consult with the store




